MARINER'S CAMP

BASIS GUIDELINES

The Mariners Camp program is designed to teach respect for people, property and the water around us. The following guidelines support the goals of the program and all Mariners Camp participants are expected to follow them. In the unlikely case a Mariner Camp participant is asked to leave the program because of a problem with conduct or with unsafe behavior, that sailor's tuition will be forfeited.

1. Each sailor must know how to swim.
2. A Vest-type life jacket must be provided by the sailor and worn at all times when on the water and/or piers. Vest-type jackets with cloth covering are available at many department stores and all boating stores. Yoke-type life jackets are not acceptable.
3. Camp is held Monday through Friday. Sailors are expected to stay each day for the complete session. Times 1:00 p.m. till 4:00 p.m. for ages 8 and up.
4. Tuition is not refunded, or prorated for days missed or planned absences for vacation etc.
5. Sailors will NOT leave the area of their class without a written permission slip from a parent.
6. Radios, phones, smart devices or any electronic device is not appropriate.
7. Dangerous, discourteous or unruly conduct is not prohibited.
